



Domaine de la Renardière Arbois-Pupillin Trousseau

Jean Michel's Trousseau is an old clone called Trousseau a la Dame. This clone is low yielding and has small berries. This adds to the complexity and density of this juicy, quirky red.

VARIETIES: 100% Trousseau a la Dame

CLASSIFICATION: Arbois-Pupillin AOC

VINEYARDS / SOILS: Red marl + clay - From various estate vineyards within the commune of Pupillin

VINE AGE: 25-30 years

FARMING: Certified organic

WINEMAKING: Hand harvested. Destemmed. Allowed to settle and start fermentation in steel, then moved to foudre or large barrel if crop is small. No SO2 added unless tough vintage and he deems it necessary. Very light working of the wine – no punchdowns, only light pumpovers. No fining or filtering.

AGING: Foudre for approximately 12 months.
